What is Reading+Mentoring 4 Success?

R+M4S is a research-based program designed to instill a love for reading in Cabarrus County students. Our three-pronged approach encourages pleasure reading, ensures that kids have plenty of books they love at home and increases the number of students who are reading proficiently before 3rd grade. Students in the program become more confident about their reading abilities, more excited about reading and read more at home and participants in the program consistently meet or exceed their reading growth goals.

Why did CCEF Launch This Program?

We are dedicated to shaping tomorrow's workforce by fostering essential life skills. We work with the business community to empower our county's students and prepare them to thrive in a rapidly changing world. All future success starts with reading! If we are to equip students for the opportunities of the future, we must ensure that they are able to read NOW! In Cabarrus County, just over half of students are reading proficiently by the end of 3rd grade. Statistics show that the achievement gap will continue to widen for those students not meeting 3rd grade benchmarks. They are far less likely to graduate and contribute fully to the community and workforce. We can and must change this!



The Impact of R+M4S

What has the program meant to our schools?

This program has impacted thousands of Cabarrus County students. In schools where R+M4S has been in operation for two or more years, we have seen:

▲ 8.5% increase in students who report reading when they are not at school.


8% increase in students who say they are excited when its time to read.

7% increase in students who believe they are good readers.

8% increase in students who say they have "a lot" of books at home.

Striving Readers Mentoring Outcomes





Mentee students outperformed their peers on exceeding expected growth by

15%

On average, students in Striving Readers Mentoring grew 118 points, 11 more than the expectation.



By the Numbers



11,000+ books given

Research shows that as few as 20 books at home has a greater impact on a child's academic success than their parents' income or education levels (University of Nevada, Reno).

2,355 students served

We hosted 9 Book-A-Paloozas, provided incentives to encourage students to read for pleasure, and 1:1 mentoring for 1st and 2nd graders to help them meet grade-level reading benchmarks at Patriots, Wolf Meadow and Weddington Hills Elementary schools.





1,103 mentoring sessions held

Our trained volunteers provided students with mentoring twice each week. 84% of students in Striving Readers Mentoring exceeded their growth goals for the year. Teachers reported that their students were more confident in the classroom as a result of the program.
